



Privacy Notice pursuant to Article 13 of EU Regulation 2016/679

This Privacy Notice is provided pursuant to Article 13 of EU Regulation 2016/679 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data (hereinafter, the "Regulation"). The Data Controller of your personal data is Base Nautica Flavio Gioia S.p.A. (hereinafter also referred to as "Base Nautica"), with registered office at Via Giuseppe Ferrari 4, Rome, Italy. The processing of your personal data is carried out for the performance of the following activities:

- Performance of obligations arising from the contract to which you are a party, including administrative and accounting activities, credit checks, statistical activities, and compliance with tax obligations established by law or regulation. If you provide your mobile phone number and/or email address, you will receive communications relating to the management of the contractual relationship. Your data may also be used to process and respond to your requests relating to our products and/or services. The legal basis for such processing is the contractual relationship with the data subject. The provision of data for the above purposes is necessary; failure to provide such data will make it impossible to enter into the contract or to receive contractual communications.

- Sending of promotional and/or advertising information regarding our products and services, as well as other promotional initiatives in favor of the data subject (direct marketing). The legal basis for carrying out these activities is your explicit consent.

Consent may be withdrawn at any time; however, such withdrawal shall not affect the lawfulness of processing based on consent given prior to withdrawal.

The Data Controller will process your identification and contact data (personal details, email address, phone number), the data necessary for the provision of the service (address, vessel registration/license plate), as well as your banking details.

The processing of personal data is carried out mainly through automated means, using appropriate security measures to ensure data protection and the highest level of confidentiality.

Processing shall be carried out in accordance with the principles of lawfulness, fairness, transparency, and protection of your privacy and rights. The personal data collected may be processed within the Data Controller's organization by authorized and properly trained personnel.

Data may be disclosed to third-party companies which, acting as Data Processors or as independent Data Controllers, support the Data Controller in the management of customer contracts, in the performance of administrative, accounting, tax and financial obligations and creditworthiness checks, IT support and consultancy, legal consultancy, verifications, audits, controls, and inspections; to banking institutions for the management of obligations arising from the performance of the contract; and to entities entitled to access personal data pursuant to laws and/or secondary regulations.

Personal data will not be disseminated and will generally not be transferred outside the European Union.

Any transfer of data outside the European Union shall take place only to entities that ensure an adequate level of data protection and/or to countries for which the competent Authorities have issued an adequacy decision, and/or to entities that have provided appropriate safeguards through suitable legal and contractual instruments, such as, by way of example, the execution of standard contractual clauses.

Personal data necessary for contract management shall be retained for the periods required by applicable laws and, in any event, for ten (10) years.

Personal data processed for direct marketing purposes shall be retained for the time strictly necessary to pursue the stated purposes and, in any event, for twenty-four (24) months from the date consent is obtained, or until consent is withdrawn.

You may request information on the origin of your data, as well as on the logic and purposes of the processing; request erasure, anonymization, or restriction of processing of data processed in violation of law; request updating, rectification, or, where applicable, integration of the data; object to processing for legitimate reasons.

You are also guaranteed the right to data portability and the right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority.
